Verona Fathers' Appeal

This weekend we welcome Fr John Downey, a priest of the Verona Fathers, for an appeal for the missionary work of the Fathers. The Verona Fathers are the designated missionary organisation in the Archdiocese this year. The Verona Fathers (also known as the Comboni Missionaries after their founder Daniel Comboni) work in Africa, Asia and Latin America. The primary aim of the Verona Fathers is to tell the Good News of Jesus Christ to people who have not yet heard it. The Missionaries approach such people, study their language and customs, and help them lead lives worthy of their human dignity by promoting health-care, education and socio-economic development. Through these activities the missionaries learn how to express the Gospel message in terms that the people can grasp and be comfortable with, while their example of compassion and concern causes the message of Christ to be heard in a context of "love God and love your neighbour as yourself".

Welsh National Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of the Taper in Cardigan

Next Sunday, May 21st, the Welsh National Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of the Taper in Cardigan led by Archbishop George Stack, takes place. This year the Pilgrimage will be enhanced by the visit of the National Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima and the Relics of the seers St. Francisco and St. Jacinta who were canonised by Pope Francis yesterday. The pilgrimage begins with Confessions at 1.30; Rosary Procession at 2.30; Mass at 3:00 and Benediction and Blessing of the Sick at 5:00. All are welcome to attend for all or part of the afternoon.
