Visit of a Sister from St. Elisabeth Convent, Minsk

On Wednesday, April 18th at 7pm in Our Lady of Lourdes and Friday, April 20th at 10am in St. Teilo's Hall we will be joined by a Sister from St. Elisabeth Convent, Minsk, a Russian Orthodox Community based in Belarus. The Sister will bring with her handmade icons and other religious artefacts made by her fellow sisters at the Convent in Minsk, so bring your wallets and purses with you to support this cause.

St Elisabeth's Convent, Minsk is dedicated to Grand Duchess Elisabeth of Russia, a Saint of the Orthodox Church, who after the assassination of her husband the Grand Duke Sergei Alexandrovich of Russia, left the Royal Court and founded a convent which cared for the poor, sick and disadvantaged. The convent in Minsk was founded in 1999 and taking up the ministry of its Patron Saint, the sisters of the convent provide spiritual and social help to the sick and the suffering. It supports 200 orphanage children with psychophysical deficiencies, a shelter for adults who have been led astray by the rough and tumble of life, (the homeless, drug or alcohol addicts, ex-prisoners and the less able) and a rehabilitation facility for women which includes female ex-prisoners, the homeless and the mentally challenged women.

In order to support their work, the Sisters undertake sewing, embroidery, candle making, woodcarving and icon making. All the articles for sale are made with love and prayer in the convent's workshops. This is a great opportunity to purchase some remarkable pieces, so please come along if you can.
