Catholic Adult Formation - Parish Bible Study Programme - The World of St Paul

The third talk in the series takes place in Our Lady of Lourdes Hall this Wednesday, February 21st. The talk is given by Dr. Alex McAuley, Lecturer in Hellenistic History at Cardiff University. The talk is open to all and does not presuppose any advance knowledge of the topic. As well as offering an insight into the society at the time when St. Paul was writing, these sessions give much content for thought and prayer as we enter into the life of the Scriptures as written by St. Paul.
