First Holy Communion children – Charity Cake Sale Next Sunday – 29th April 2018

The children who are preparing for First Holy Communion decided that they would like to bake cakes and sell them after Mass to raise money for charity. Canon Isaac suggested that the money raised could be donated to a charity that is supported by an eye surgeon from the University Hospital of Wales who Travels overseas periodically to operate on people in the Himalayas who are suffering from snow blindness. The cakes will be on sale after the 9am and 11am Mass on Sunday, April 29th. We ask you to support the children to raise money for this worthy cause and to remember them in your prayers.

Rosary on the Coast – Sunday the 29th of April at 3.00pm

In a change to the original plans, the Cardiff Oratory and Chaplaincy community will now be celebrating the Rosary on the Coast with the Parish of Our Lady and St Illtyd in Llantwit Major. Fr. Mark Rowles, Parish Priest of Llantwit will lead the event at the seaside in Llantwit Major beach parking area. (Postcode CF61 1YX.) The Rosary will commence at 3pm.

The Polish Catholic Community here in Cardiff will be leading the Rosary at the same time at Penarth Pier. Though the Rosary will be said in Polish, all are welcome to attend on Sunday and join in in our own language.

Please make an effort to attend to pray the Rosary along with Catholics from all over Britain. The day of Pilgrimage and Prayer called Rosary on the Coast has three intentions (a) for the re-flourishing of our Faith (b) for the grace to build a Culture of Life (c) for true peace to reign in the hearts of all peoples and nations. If you are not able to make it to the outdoor praying of the Rosary you are encouraged to join in prayer at home or in the parish church. In addition, again for those who are not able to attend any of the coastal venues, the prayers will take place at St Joseph’s Church, New Zealand Road. The programme will be as follows: 2.45pm Invocation of the Holy Spirit and Prayers of Protection; 2.50pm Act of Contrition and Scripture Reading; 3.00pm The Glorious Mysteries of the Most Holy Rosary; 3.30pm Litany of Our Lady; 3.40pm Prayer invoking St. Joseph; 3.50pm Litany invoking the Saints of the British Isles.

Inspired by the faithful of Poland and Ireland, who recently encircled their countries with prayer to Jesus, it is expected that Catholics across England, Scotland and Wales will do the same on this day. Please take part, physically, or by prayer, to support the intentions of bringing our countries back to the Lord Jesus, through the patronage of His Divine Mother.

Mental Health First Aid

Do you deal with members of the public who may be suffering from mental health issues? Are you unsure how best to respond? The Archdiocese of Cardiff is subsidising a 2-day Mental Health First Aid course, which will run from 11am until 5pm on Friday, June 15th and Friday, June 22nd 2018. The course runs in parallel at two venues on the same dates, in Cardiff at the Pastoral Resources Centre and in Pontypool at St Alban's High School. You can learn more and book online via the Diocesan Website at RCADC.org. If you do not have web access, call Madeline Page on 029 2036 5965. The course normally costs £120 but the diocese is making it available at £30 per person. There are currently 9 spaces available in Pontypool and 4 in Cardiff, so do book quickly.
