#### Week beginning 24th/25th June 2017 The Twelfth Sunday of Ordinary Time

#### Congratulations

We offer our congratulations to Rev. Nicholas Williams who was ordained Deacon last Saturday. We look forward to Deacon Nicholas coming to visit us in the near future to preach at Mass.

#### Ordinary Time

Today, after Lent, Easter and the associated feasts, the Church returns to Ordinary Time with today being the 12th Sunday of Ordinary Time. Ordinary Time is 'Tempus per annum' in Latin, which is sometimes translated as 'Time during the Year'. Ordinary Time is the period of the year when the Church reads regularly through a particular Gospel. This year, Year A, is the year when we reflect on the Gospel of Matthew.

Of the four Gospels, it is Matthew's which is focused on the Jewish Christian community. This Gospel, more than any of the others, uses quotations from the Old Testament to root the message of Jesus in the tradition of the people of Israel. As we listen to Matthew's Gospel during this year, let us focus on Jesus as the Messiah and on our role in the Church as the new people of Israel. The Gospel of Matthew is modelled on the Books of Moses, the Law and as such, the Gospel focuses on Jesus's fulfilment of the Law and the new commandment He proclaims. The Gospel shows Jesus as the great Teacher who shows us the way to the Promised Land, just as Moses led the original people of Israel to the Promised Land. Jesus teaches his audience the truth of the loving relationship with God, first by reducing the Ten Commandments to two, love of God and love of neighbour, which govern our relationships and by His own personal invitation leading us to a loving relationship with the Father through Him. Jesus continues to teach, with His own authority, a far more demanding, interior and spiritual morality than was ever required by Israelite laws, prophets, sages or scribes. We are invited to listen to the words of the Gospel and live our lives in response to the call of Jesus to love His Father with our whole being and to love others as we love ourselves.
