### Adoremus – Celebrating Corpus Christi



Next Sunday is the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, when we celebrate the Eucharistic presence of Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. In this year of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage and Congress in Liverpool, we are invited to spend a little extra time this Corpus Christi to celebrate the great gift of the Holy Eucharist that Jesus left us. There are three opportunities this coming weekend in which you can honour Our Lord. Why not come along, to one, two or all of them?

### ADOREMUS – Eucharistic Procession and Mass - Friday, June 1st

Next Friday, the Friday before the feast of Corpus Christi, the three parishes in North Cardiff will come together to celebrate our Eucharistic Faith through a Eucharistic Procession and Mass at St. Philip Evans Church. This Mass will be the only Mass in the three parishes on Friday. There is no Friday morning Mass here at St. Teilo's. The timetable for the evening will be as follows:

5.45pm – Pre-event snacks: crisps, nibbles, vegetable samosas, tuna sandwiches in Hall

6.30pm – Eucharistic Procession at 6.30 pm Coed-y-Gores, out onto Circle Way and back through the estate

7.30pm – Mass in honour of the Most Blessed Eucharist

## **Advanced Notice – First Mass of Fr. David Prichard – Sunday July 1st at 6.30pm**

Deacon David Prichard is to be ordained for the Ordinariate on Saturday, June 30th. Fr. (as he will be on that date) David is going to celebrate his First Mass at St. Teilo's at 6.30pm on Sunday, July 1st. All are welcome to join Fr. David and his family for this celebration.

### **Deacon David writes:**

As many of you will know, I am due to be ordained to the Sacred Priesthood on Saturday, June 30th. This will take place at the Birmingham Oratory - not in our own Archdiocese - and several people have asked me why this should be.

The reason is that I am a member of the Personal Ordinariate of Our Lady of Walsingham. This is a separate and distinct part of the Catholic Church, yet in full Communion with the Holy Father and therefore we are all Catholics. The Ordinariate has its own Missal and Office books, known as the Ordinariate Use (a variation of the familiar Western Roman Rite). Ordinariate priests have canonical permission to use both their own Mass books and the books of the mainstream Roman Rite.

The Ordinariate is a generous provision of the Holy Father that has allowed Christians who were previously of the Anglican Communion to enter the Catholic Church, bringing with them their own traditions of sacred music, liturgy and scholarship, (referred to collectively as our 'Patrimony'), as gifts to be shared. Our Patron is Blessed Cardinal John Henry Newman, who was himself a prominent Anglican scholar before his reception into the Church. Cardinal Newman went on to found the Congregation of the Oratory in Birmingham, hence the choice of venue for the ordination of eight men as priests of the Ordinariate, myself included, on June 30th. I minister in the Parish of St. Teilo's with Our Lady of Lourdes by permission of His Grace Archbishop George Stack and at the kind invitation of Canon William as Parish Priest. I also work at UHW as a Chaplain. On Sunday, July 1st, I shall be saying Mass, Ordinariate Use, for the first time at St Teilo's at 6.30pm. You are all warmly invited to join me for this celebration.
